RIGHT TO KNOW: Prior to application of pesticides to your property, State law requires that you be given the following information:

CAUTION - PESTICIDES ARE TOXIC CHEMICALS. Structural Pest Control Operators are licensed and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board and apply pesticides which are registered and approved for use by the California Department of Food and Agriculture and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the state finds that, based on existing scientific evidence, there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized. If, within 24 hours following application, you experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illnesses comparable to the flu, contact your physician or poison control center (800-876-4766) and your pest control operator immediately. If rodenticide (Confrac) ingestion occurs, you may experience symptoms of mild shock/bleeding, an anticoagulant reaction.
